As is traditional, organizers figured out how old the oldest visitor was that evening – 85 years old – as well as the youngest, who was 9 months old.

A round of Christmas carols followed before Young performed "Mary Did You Know?" just prior to Doug Merk, a missionary to Notla River Baptist Association, who read aloud the story of Christmas.

Mike's sister, Ami Young, sang "O Holy Night," which led into the lighting of the tree by Becker.

Many more carols ensued, including the candlelit "Silent Night," and both Becker and Hill gave parting

words to the more than 600 in attendance.

Pastor George Cline of Antioch Baptist Church offered a prayer before the closing of the evening.

Event organizers and the park would like to thank everyone who made the event possible, including the churches, park volunteers, those in attendance, and workers from the Blue Ridge Mountain EMC, who helped to decorate the big tree and the visitor's center.
