State Sen. Steve Gooch helped the City of Blairsville to secure the largest portion of funding for the new terminal, which will be coming through GDOT.

"If it hadn't have been for Steve Gooch's support of the City of Blairsville in getting this \$562,000 in DOT funding, we wouldn't be talking about build-ing a terminal today," said Mayor Conley. "He secured that money for us in the 2015 session of the General Assembly."

The state has agreed to pay 75 percent of the project up to \$562,000, with the city needing to come up with the remaining 25 percent of the funding or however much is needed after the state funding cap has been all bids are in.

Both bidders estimated in the pre-bid meeting that the project should take no longer than six or seven months to complete once started, and all are optimistic the project will begin by or around July 1, which is the deadline to obtain the state funding.

Landau, the local architect who designed the plans, said that he believes the new terminal will have a "wow effect."

"They'll say, 'Oh wow, how nice is this? I thought you were a small town, and yet it has a bigger town feel," said Landau. "It's not a huge building it's only 4,700 square feet. But it's going to feel big because it's a big open space when you walk
